The **TRAIL CHALLENGE COURSE CLINIC** — June 18, 2011. Cost : \$150

Instructed by Kail Mantle, this small group clinic allows you and your horse to spend the day working on each element and the horsemanship necessary to perfect the obstacle. Individualized instruction is concentrated on proficiency at recreational level as well as competition suggestions. Individual and group instruction is provided on horsemanship and when necessary, training or re-training for your horse. (Participation in clinic or lessons disqualifies participants from competing in the NOVICE division.) Class size is limited.

Registration begins Saturday 8-9am. Please be saddled and ready to ride out by 9am. Lunch will be provided. Expect to work on the Course until dinner time. Review Course Notes and Competition Rules on website for more information.

Pens are available for \$5 per night, provide your own water buckets, feed, and clean-up. Free camping in primitive areas, or use your trailers. We have a two cabins available for \$75 per night, sleeps 4 singles each. There are two RV hookups with elec. and sewer (no water) for \$25 per night. Reserve ahead of time, space is limited.
